(840 Tag or Brite/Bangs Tags)

BEEF CATTLE - CLASSES

Age Definitions:

- **JUNIOR CALF** - Born on or after January 1 of exhibit year. Calf must be at least 4 months old at the time of exhibit.
 - **SENIOR CALF** - Born September 1 to December 31 of year preceding exhibit year.
 - **SUMMER YEARLING** - Born between May 1 and August 31 of year preceding exhibit year.
 - **JUNIOR YEARLING** - Born between January 1 and April 30 of year preceding exhibit year.
 - **SENIOR YEARLING** - Born between September 1 and December 31 of second year preceding exhibit year.
 - **2 YEAR OLD & OLDER** - Born before September 1 of second year preceding exhibit year and which has calved during the past year.
 - **BEEF JUNIOR-GET-OF-SIRE** - shall consist of 3 animals which are offspring of the same bull and are animals in the junior calf, senior calf, and/or summer yearling, bull and heifer classes, with both sexes to be represented.
 - **BEEF SENIOR GET-OF-SIRE** - shall consist of 3 animals which are the offspring of one sire. All of these animals shall be 2 years of age or over. The name of the sire shall be designated by the exhibitor. The animals need not be owned by a single exhibitor.
- ✓ **All Beef Cattle will be entered on Wednesday of the fair, by 4 p.m.**
 - ✓ **Vet Check-In Sheet.** You must have the sheets properly filled out when bringing in your animals, along with ID number and vet inspection certificate and/or test papers. All vet check-in sheets **MUST** be filled out and given to the Department Superintendent. Those who **DO NOT** have their sheets filled out will not be checked in and will be asked to leave. The vet check is in the barns **at 5 p.m.** Animals must be in place and paperwork filled out completely **prior to 5 p.m.**
 - ✓ Premises ID number is required.

SAWDUST: The Richland County Fair Committee has ruled that a **SAWDUST BASE OF 4"** will be allowed in the barns. Woods shavings or shredded paper will be allowed but not bark.

Fitting chutes cannot be placed by the north gateways of the livestock barn.

Registered Breed – LIMIT: 2 PER ENTRY

CLASS – BREEDING BEEF

***Cow-Calf Pair – NO PREMIUMS, TROPHY ONLY.** This is a non-state-aided event. Junior Division and Open Division show together and no exhibitor and no exhibitor ticket is required if only entering this class.

***Any purebred or commercial beef bred cow and calf** pair is eligible to be shown in this entry. The cow must be shown on halter. Calf must be born on or after January 1 of current fair year.
