## Fair & Recycling Committee Meeting

Doudna again discussed the upcoming Clean Sweep Event next month for the County. B. Marshall and Gald will work on the traffic flow with B. Marshall, Doudna, Wastlick and Peters working the event. Review of the survey that was done in the past will be done again this year.

The Committee will continue to have discussions with Emergency Management, Sheriff's Department, UW Extension Staff, Department Superintendents and Meat Animal Sale Staff as needed.

B. Marshall reviewed the meeting dates and times again with everyone.
